The Regular Meeting of the Stroud Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairwoman & Secretary, Jennifer Shukaitis at 7:04 P.M., Also present were Vice Chairman & Ass't. Treasurer, Edward Cramer; Supervisor/Ass't. Secretary, Susan Lyons; Township Manager, Daryl A. Eppley; Lori Foglio, RLA from Reilly Associates; Township Solicitor, Todd Weitzmann; and Recording Secretary, Janice Willey.

Manager's Report: Mr. Eppley reported Rylind Construction is progressing to close-out the Mervine Road bridge replacement project. They will be requesting final payment and I will submit for grant reimbursement. Telco, Inc. is waiting for modems from PennDOT which has extended the grant contract until December 31, 2024 on the Green Light-Go, signal coordination project on Route 611. An adjourning property owner to Lessig Lane bridge granted access permission to American Engineers Group for completion of survey work and obtaining stream cross sections. The two property owners adjoining Croasdale Road bridge have been contacted about entry to their properties by American engineers Group for preliminary engineering work. The United Way has coordinated a meeting to discuss homeless encampments in Monroe County May 30th at 11 AM in the 2nd floor Community Conference Room, Monroe County Administration Building. 2024 Pavement Marking bid package has been prepared and advertised. I spoke to contractor representatives about the Penn Hills demolition unit costs for the disposal of concrete to landfill and spreading of crushed concrete on site as permitted by DEP. Scraping of steel was also discussed and I will prepare draft bid documents for review. Park patrol will start collecting non-resident user fees starting this weekend and security will start. The golf course has been doing better as weather has improved.

<u>Public Works Dept. Report</u>: Mr. Eppley read from Josh Cramer's report. Spring Clean-up went very well, the crew, Janice and Sharon did an excellent job. Spring Leaf Pick-up also went well. We have been dealing with a lot of water complaints, fixing blacktop curbing, cleaning brush from the parks, patching rear parking lot at the township building and Gaunt Road. Also, working on cutting shoulders on Sky Pine Way and Hickory Valley Road. Installation of new tracks for the 308 excavator and new hydraulic pump for the Mobark grinder. Working on MS4 projects. Craig Coslar, mechanic worked with the ODB representative and SEI mechanic on the new leaf pickers to fix issues. And working on Request for Action forms.

<u>Police Report</u>: Lieutenant Sampere attended the meeting representing the Police Department. Asked if the board had any questions, they did not.

<u>Solicitor's Report</u>: Mr. Weitzmann did not have anything to report outside of executive session.

Engineer's Report: Ms. Foglio summarized Reilly Associates monthly report.

Fire Department Report: Brian McCartney summarized the Fire Department's report.
